

Inexpensive Banner Frame

PVC Banner frames: Versatile and inexpensive to make, can be used indoors with “feet” or outdoors on rebar stakes. We recommend using the thick wall 1” Dia. PVC pipe and parts. All parts and pipe shown below are white, these are color coded for ease of part identification. Frame size to banner proportions can be adjusted for your mounting preference.

90 Degree
“Elbow”
(2 pieces)

How to figure frame size: Add 4 - 6” to the finished banner size and cut the pipes accordingly, remember about 1 inch of pipe goes into each elbow and tee. When in doubt, add a couple extra inches, you can always cut twice. The frame can be press fit for compact storage or glued with PVC adhesive. Banner can be attached to the frame with cable ties, bungies, or string.

3 Way “Tee”
(2 pieces)

“Feet” (see below) can be used indoors or outdoors, pipe length can be longer for wind stability and weights can be used if needed. For outdoor mounting, use 2 pieces of rebar sunk about 18” into the ground and slip the legs over the rebar. The rebar should stick up enough to almost reach the bottom horizontal pipe.

3 Way “Tee”
